		<b>Now you put the egg under the table.</b>	Puts <b>Object</b> card in place.	<b>Where's the table?</b> <b><u>Under</u> the table.</b>
		<b>Which is the balloon/radio?</b>	Points to <b>Object</b> card.	<b>Is this the balloon/radio?</b> <b>(pointing to balloon/radio)</b>
		<b>Put the balloon/radio between the lamp and the door.</b>	Puts <b>Object</b> card in place.	<b>Where are the lamp and the door?</b> <b><u>Between</u> the lamp and the door.</b>
	Remove <b>Object</b> cards and point to the red lorry in <b>Scene</b> picture.	<b>Now, *, what's this?</b> <b>What colour is it?</b> <b>How many lorries/trucks are there?</b>	<b>lorry/truck</b> <b>red</b> <b>two</b>	<b>Is it a lorry/truck?</b> <b>Is it green? Red?</b> <b>Is there one? Two?</b>
	Point to the baby.	<b>What's the baby doing?</b>	<b>sleeping</b>	<b>Is she sleeping?</b>
