3.2	Shows chair card.	What's this? Are there lots of chairs in your classroom? What colour is this chair?	(a) chair yes/no <i>blue</i>	Is it a chair? Is this chair blue?
3.3	Shows jacket card.	What's this? Do you wear a jacket at school? What do you like wearing?	(a) jacket yes/no <i>T-shirts</i>	Is it a jacket? Do you like wearing T-shirts?
